Who Do I Need to Notify When Moving to a New House?

- ☐ Water, gas, and electricity companies
- ☐ Telephone provider
- ☐ The Post Office (mail redirection)
- ☐ Satellite TV and Internet provider
- TV licensing
- ☐ Your bank and credit card company
- Council tax and electoral register
- ☐ Your workplace/employer and HMRC
- ☐ Insurance companies car, house etc
- Doctor, dentist, and optician
- ☐ DVLA
- ☐ Schools, colleges, and universities
- ☐ Subscriptions magazines, food delivery
- ☐ Vets, pet microchip, and pet insurance

Home Moving Checklist

A handy six-week guide to help you plan and manage all your home moving tasks



Step 1 5-6 Weeks Before You Move

- Have a clear out and declutter
- Obtain packing materials and boxes if you plan to do your own packing
- ☐ Start ordering new furniture if needed
- ☐ Arrange a survey with your removals company
- Research your new area

3-4 Weeks Before You Move Step 2

- ☐ Book your removal company
- Arrange childcare or pet care for moving day
- Organise home insurance for your new home
- ☐ Start to run down your fridge and freezer
- ☐ Make sure there is parking for your removals company at your new home
- ☐ Arrange for post to be redirected





2 Weeks Before You Move Step 3

- Notify your essential service providers of your move
- ☐ Transfer your phone number, and arrange for internet services at your new address
- Reclaim spare keys from neighbours, family and friends
- ☐ Arrange to dispose of any flammable or dangerous liquids, as your moving company cannot transport these for you
- Plan the moving day in detail

1 Week Before You Move

- Finish packing (if you've arranged to do it yourself) and clean the house thoroughly
- ☐ Make sure all vital documents are together and set aside for you to move yourself
- ☐ Defrost and clean the fridge freezer
- ☐ Check loft, garage, basement, shed, and all less frequently used areas of the house for any items you might have forgotten
- ☐ Confirm all details with your moving company

The Day Before You Move

- ☐ Pack your moving day survival kit, with everything you will need for the big day
- Empty all the bins
- ☐ Gather all your essentials, jewellery and important documents and mark as 'do not remove' so you can transport yourself
- ☐ Write notes for the new occupants with details of bin collections, alarms etc.
- Do final house check

The Day Of The Move

- ☐ Greet and instruct the movers when they arrive
- ☐ Take final meter readings and submit to utility suppliers
- Once the crew have finished, walk through the property to confirm nothing has been left behind
- Collect your keys and arrive at your new home ahead of the removals company
- On completion of the removals delivery, check all items have been unloaded and sign any removals paperwork
